FootGolf Rules

Before you start.

1. Check in and collect your scorecards from the Cluny reception or log cabin.
2. Make sure your ball is easy to identify.

On the tee:

3. Wear outdoor clothing and wear footwear appropriate for the weather - Football boots are NOT allowed.
4. Take care of the FootGolf course, rake bunkers and maintain a proper pace of play.
5. Make sure your kick will not interfere with other players and wait your turn.
6. Kick off your ball from a position up to two meters (6 feet) behind the tee markers.
7. You are not allowed to push the ball with the top or bottom of your foot. Your foot should be set separate from the ball, clearly behind, before each kick.
8. Wait to play until the ball has completely come to rest. (It is not allowed to stop the ball from rolling with the wind).

During the play of a hole:

9. Play the ball from where it lies. You are not allowed to move the ball or remove jammed objects. *Exception: You may mark the spot and lift the ball when it may obstruct the other player's kick or ball in any way.*
10. Do not kick if it is possible to interfere with the group ahead of you.
11. If the ball in play is moved or deflected or stopped by another ball the player must play his ball as it is and replace the ball moved. There is no penalty unless both balls are on the putting green in which case the player who hit incurs a penalty of two strokes.
12. If the ball lands in water, retrieve or replace it within 2 steps from the closest land point from where the ball went in. There is a one stroke penalty.
13. Sand Bunkers: play the ball as it lies. There is no penalty. Remember to rake the bunker after you have played.

Cluny Activities - FootGolf Rules

- Do not walk on Golf Greens.
- Please see FootGolf Map for routing of each hole.
- The Pace of Play Standard for FootGolfers is 2 hours. Please make sure to keep up with the group in front of you. Groups falling behind our pace of play standard will be moved forward to recapture their position on the course.
- No personal or outside food or beverage is allowed.
